

Horseback Riding Programs

For Troop Core Camp

Welcome to Camp Roundelay's riding program! Our goal is to provide an opportunity for riders to learn life skills (level 2 skills) such as responsibility, trust, and confidence through horseback riding and horse related activities. We offer a variety of programs to meet the needs of all of your girls. Since our programs are designed for different ability levels we do prefer that you split up your group according to each rider's ability. Girls will have more fun with other girls of the same experience level since groups have to ride at the level of the least experienced rider. If you think your girls are skilled enough for a program that they do not meet the age requirement for, please talk to the Horse Program Manager.

Programs for Brownies

Boots and Bales (BAB)

Requirements: Grade 2 and up
Cost: \$15 per person
Duration: 1 1/2 hours

This is an introductory program oriented to teach safety and expose girls to steering horses independently. Program includes a safety orientation, pony ride, and fun ground activity.

Programs for Juniors and up

Barrels of Fun with Horses (BOF)

Requirements: Grade 4 and up
Cost: \$20 per person
Duration: 2 hours

This is a beginner program oriented to teach safety and expose girls to beginning riding skills. Program includes a safety orientation and a mounted lesson.

Barrels of Fun with Horses II (BOF2)

Requirements: Grade 7 and up
Cost: \$30 per person
Duration: 3 hours

This is a beginner program oriented to teach safety and expose older girls to intermediate riding skills. Program includes a safety orientation, mounted lesson, opportunity to try trotting or an introductory trail ride.

Trail Adventures

Happy Trails (HPT)

Requirements: Grade 6 and up

Cost: \$25 per person

Duration: 2 hours

This is an intermediate program oriented to teach safety and expose girls to beginner trail riding. Program includes safety orientation, trail rules, beginner trail ride and knot tying.

Happy Trails II (HPT2)

Requirements: Grade 7 and up

Cost: \$30 per person

Duration: 3 hours

This is an intermediate program oriented to teach safety and expose girls to tacking a horse and intermediate trail riding. Program includes a safety orientation, trail rules, an intermediate trail ride and tacking their own horse.

Notes for Troop Leaders:

- Riding activities are weather dependent - high heat, heavy rain, storms, etc ... will affect riding. Troop riding programs will be scheduled with the Camp Director and Horse Program Manager at the Troop Camp Orientation meeting when you arrive at camp.
- Large troops will be split into smaller groups for safety and more effective learning.
- The cost is per participant
- The equivalents to the troop camp riding programs are as follows:
 - o Happy Trails = completion of Pony Club
 - o Happy Trails II = completion of Saddle Club
- At least one leader/adult needs to be with the girls at the Ranch
